1. **Call to Order.**
 2. **Roll Call of Officers**
 - a. Marilyn Flowers, and Esther Robinson present.
 3. **Guest Speaker: Lieutenant Harry Peterson of Western District Police Department.** Harry Peterson from AACWD discussed Crime Prevention x6155. A. Discussed locking car doors and garage doors as we head into the summer season. Don't leave valuables visible in locked or unlocked cars. (E.g. laptops or cellphones). B. If you see something say something. Call 911 if you see anything suspicious or have an emergency. C. Get to know your neighbors. Don't leave vital information on Facebook (e.g. vacation plans.) Leave emergency numbers with neighbors. D. Call if you see anything in progress using the emergency number, 911, for emergencies. Call the non-emergency number 410-222- 8610 for non-emergencies such as abandoned vehicles. West County Station's number is 410-222-6155. Do not call this one for emergencies because they do not always pick up, and they are not a dispatch. Call it to get to specific police persons or cases, etc., that do not require an officer to be dispatched. E. Abandon cars get towed Mon-Friday 8-3 pm. No towing on the weekends. Must be visible that a vehicle is inoperable such as all tires are flat or expired tags. Contact Officer Corporal Middleton and leave voicemail for abandon vehicles he can check them out. F. Sergeant White can be contacted for drug information and leave messages about drug information. He is part of the Narcotics Unit. So if you see suspicious activity. Leave a voice message with any pertinent info and your contact info and he will respond. G. If you see problem rentals or landlords be sure to report to zoning or police. H. Solicitors are allowed in the neighborhood. It is better to have a no trespassing sign than a no solicitors sign. Elected Officers/Candidates can go door to door they are not considered solicitors.
